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Project Title: How To Crochet a Rose

Time to Make: 30 minutes

Skill Level: Intermediate

You Will Need:

Yarn - DK

Scissors

Knitters sewing needle

Crochet hook - 4mm

Abbreviations:

Ch - chain

SS - slip stitch

Htr- half treble

DC - double crochet

Introduction to the Project: These Crochet Roses are really easy to make and are quick enough that you can make a whole bunch in very little time at all. Pair them with florist wire to make a bouquet or adorn your clothes and blankets with them for that little extra touch.

Step 1:

Row 1: ch 61 (Image 1)

Step 2:

Row 2: In 2nd ch from hook, 1dc then *ch2, skip next ch, 1dc into next ch* - repeat *to* to end of the chain. (Image 2)

Step 3:

Row 3: Turn your work, ch1. In 1st chain space 3htr, ch1, ss.

In next chain space ss, ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss.

In next chain space ss, ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss.

In the remaining 27 chain spaces, follow pattern as previous chain space, but alternate between 4htr and 5htr (Image 3 and 4) so that your petals vary. It doesn't matter too much if you lose track as no two roses are the same. Fasten off and weave in ends using your needle.

Step 4:

Thread your needle with a length of yarn the same colour as your rose and begin to role your rose starting with the smallest, 3tr petals. Sew the rose together as you go along, until it is fully formed (Image 5)

You now have a beautiful crochet rose.
